MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE LAND MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF FRESHWATER PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON 24th APRIL 2024 AT 9.30AM IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE MEMORIAL HALL

1. APOLOGIES:

2. STROUD COPPICE

The deputy Clerk made copies of the paperwork from Wayne Isaacson for Cllrs to take away and read through

3. PLAY EQUIPMENT ON STROUD

It was agreed that a replacement seesaw should be purchased. It was agreed that the deputy clerk would source some play equipment brochures and let the councillors know, when they arrive, and they can come and collect them to look at them. The deputy clerk reminded everyone that the safety inspections for the Play Areas, Skate Park and Muga are due to take place in May. It was decided in the end to wait and see the outcome of the inspections before making any final decisions.

4. GRANNY'S MEADE

Cllr Bray confirmed that 3 new memorial trees and 2 new benches are to be installed in Granny's Meade. They are being purchased and installed by the families requesting them.
